#### PREVIOUS CAPITAL BUDGET Last Budget Cycle Recap


Significantly reduced General Fund commitment due to COVID-19

- 2-Year General Fund Investment: \$101M \$48.3M funded in FY22 and \$52.6M funded in FY23
- Critical Repairs and Recovery Stimulus Programs provided an additional \$111M in support
- > 2-Year Other Sources Investment: \$140M

**TOTAL 2-Year Investment: \$352M** 



### PREVIOUS CAPITAL BUDGET Historical Budget Allocations




- 356 total project requests received

- Significant cost overruns for previously funded projects due to delays, escalation & scope changes
- Unaddressed large state-of-good-repair needs such as HVAC, elevators, roofs etc. coming due
- Depts. not ready for upcoming Chapter 7 changes, such as allelectric HVAC systems, due to aged electrical infrastructure and associated costs
- > Depts. requesting increase in Facilities Maintenance allocations
- > Several requests for Critical Project Development
